## Year 10 Examinations

Hopefully you have been made aware from your child, that all Year 10 students will have their Year 10 examinations between Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May and Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May (inclusive).

There are 3 examinations that sit outside of this window; Art – completed last week, Food practical – either 23<sup>rd</sup> or 24<sup>th</sup> April (as confirmed in a ParentMail sent 14<sup>th</sup> March) and Drama practical on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May. (NB. The Drama exam is part of the actual GCSE and therefore any absence must be supported with a doctor's certificate).

We call these exams Pre-Public Examinations - PPEs, but many students and parents refer to them as mock exams. Attendance is compulsory and I appreciate all your support in ensuring your child has full attendance. If they are unable to attend, please can I ask you to call or email Watling Attendance to let us know prior to the onset of the exam.

To support students to prepare for these exams, I have scheduled a Year 10 revision day on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> March. This day will consist of:

- Learning how to revise.
- Learning how to plan for revision.
- Coping with exam stress.
- Understanding why revision will improve outcomes.
- How to revise using online platforms.





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Teachers will also be going through revision in their lessons prior to the exams.
