Dear Parents and Carers,

Relationships and Sex Education - YEAR 9

As a part of your child's education at Watling Academy, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know that over the next 6 weeks, your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) aspect of this programme.

RSE lessons in year 9 will include teaching about:

- Respectful relationship behaviours
- Freedom and capacity to consent
- Sexual health
- Contraception
- Managing the ending of relationships
- Dangers of online pornography.

Pupils will also have opportunities to ask questions that help prepare them for relationships of all kinds in the modern world.

PSHE education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body.
