## Year 7 Mandarin Excellence Programme Hurdle Tests Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May

Firstly, I want to congratulate your child on the excellent efforts they have made this year on the Mandarin Excellence Programme. On Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May, your child will be completing Hurdle Tests. Hurdle Tests are annual external assessments and are a compulsory part of the programme. All MEP students across the country sit these assessments. They are excellent preparation for their other examinations as they work towards their GCSEs. Details on how best to prepare have been added to ClassCharts.

On Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> and Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May, most students will complete their speaking assessment. This is a 1-to-1 speaking assessment with their teacher. As a result, they will attend lessons as normal. They will only leave a lesson five minutes before they are due to start their assessment. Your child will be given their own individual appointment slip. If they lose the slip, teaching staff have a copy of their time. So, they can check with any member of teaching staff.

On Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May your child will be absent from lessons 1-5 to prepare and complete the reading, listening and writing parts of the assessment. As a result, please do not buy any food ingredients if they would normally have Food Technology on a Thursday, as they will need to complete their Hurdle Tests. The Twilight lesson will take place as usual on this day, as some speaking assessments will need to take place during the afternoon.
