As you know, when we first opened Watling Academy, I said that it was a priority of the CEO, Governors, staff and myself, as Headteacher, to secure Sixth Form provision for Watling Academy students and that wholeheartedly remains the case. In the background, my team and I have been working flat out on the Sixth Form project.

There has been a huge amount of work, time and effort gone on behind the scenes around Sixth Form planning. Last autumn, we heard from the DfE Academies Minister that we were successfully granted the change of age from 11-16 to now 11-18.
