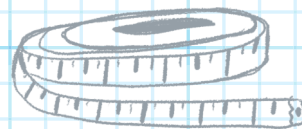

Making

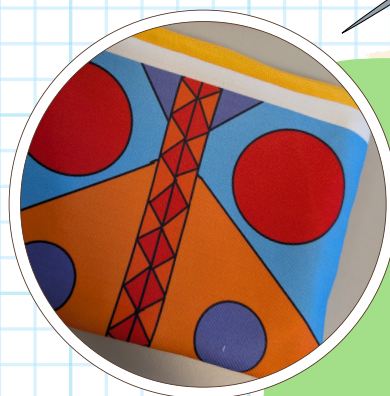

You will be assessed at the end of your project on your subject knowledge and understanding.

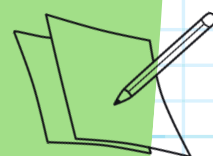
